3) Committee Reports

- a) City Inspector and Safety Reports Paul Schneidenbach shall ensure the attendance of the City Housing Inspector and WMU/KPS Safety Officer for a community report at the January, March, May and October Board meetings, relieving Grace from the WMU/KPS coordination duty.
- b) Arcadia Representation on City Commissions/Boards/Committees J. Carroll previously suggested that Arcadia representation on City committees as the best way to stay informed about City planning and development projects and to allow Arcadia input on decisions affecting Kalamazoo and Arcadia. James Robinson, II has applied for the one of the three open Planning Commission seats. J. Carroll is a current Zoning Board of Appeals Member. - c) Open Space Committee (Chairman Rex B.) Rec B. Reports that the City Planner has confirmed that Walden Woods development has approval to build on the 20 acres set aside by the 2005 West Side City Plan. Rex will present a history of the Arboretum woods and its development on the Arcadia website to educate residents, pointing out that "planning" is not enough. Additional actions such as purchasing lands, City counsel resolutions and other legal measures should be sought when attempting to ensure a plan adherence.

- a) Objectives: To gather Arcadia neighborhood input to be used for goal setting during the Neighborhood Planning Process. Particularly in light of the Future Use Map change for the north side of W/ Michigan between Farrell and Eldridge

- (1) Style: Similar to Imagine Kalamazoo public meetings which gathered citizen input for the 2025 Master Plan. To include City representatives from the Planning, Streets and Parks departments; using large maps of the neighborhood to solicit and document suggests by attendees. The president of WMU will be asked to attend as well.
- ii) Survey no more than 5 questions with room for individual comments to be available on the ANA website no later than May 1, 2018. Face Book, ANA minutes, and website campaign to increase participation. Also, a door to door campaign in early May will be organized to allow taking the survey in person or for drop off at a board members house or at the Community Meeting.
